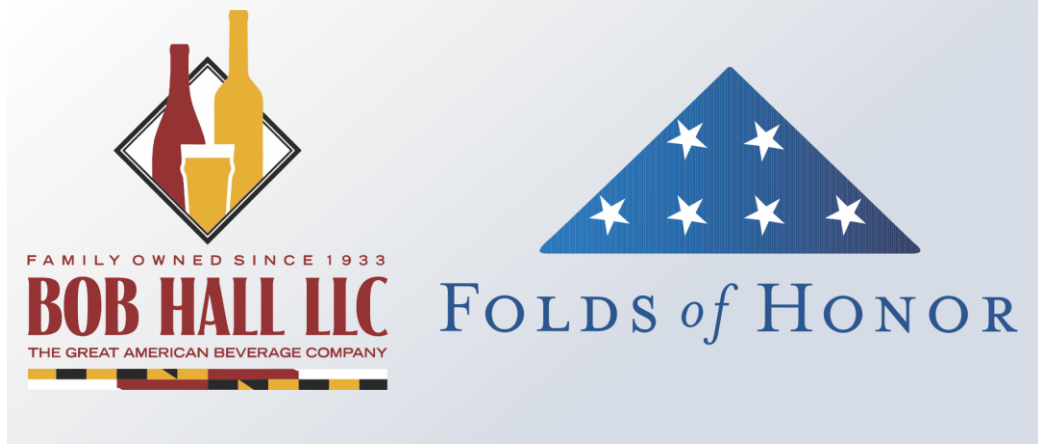

BOB HALL, LLC TO DONATE FOUR SCHOLARSHIPS TO FOLDS OF HONOR FOUNDATION

SCHOLARSHIPS TO BE AWARDED TO LOCAL RESIDENTS

Dateline: UPPER MARLBORO, MD, June 21, 2023 — Bob Hall, LLC will once again donate one dollar (\$1.00) for every case of Budweiser and Bud Light sold at local Off-premise retailers, and fifty-cents (\$0.50) for every Budweiser and Bud Light 16oz. aluminum bottle sold in On-Premise accounts, from May 29th to July 31st 2023 (up to \$20,000.00) to the Folds of Honor foundation. This award will fund four scholarships for local U.S. military spouses or children of service men and women who have fallen or have been disabled while serving in the United States Armed Forces, as well as families of first responders.

Bob Hall, LLC joins Anheuser-Busch in supporting the Folds of Honor mission to help those in need. "Folds of Honor is such an amazing and worthy foundation; how can we not do all we can to honor those who have given so much. We look to support those family members left behind," **said Dan Hoose, General Manager of Bob Hall, LLC.** "We are eternally grateful for those who serve our country and communities, and stand for its freedom and safety. We want to do all we can to educate their legacy."

Of the one million-plus dependents adversely affected by deployments to Iraq and Afghanistan, nearly nine out of 10 do not qualify for federal scholarship assistance. Folds of Honor seeks to meet this need by providing annual educational scholarships to the military families of those who have been killed or disabled. Starting in 2022, the Folds' mission expanded to include first responders.

The scholarships help support private school tuition or tutoring for children K-12, as well as higher education tuition assistance for spouses and children.

Bob Hall was founded in 1933, the same year as the repeal of Prohibition, by Robert Lee Hall, Jr., better known as Bob Hall. About Folds of Honor

Folds of Honor is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that provides educational scholarships to the spouses and children of military members who have fallen or been disabled while serving in the United States Armed Forces. Beginning in 2022, it expanded its mission to include first responders. Our educational scholarships support private school tuition or tutoring in grades K-12, tuition for college, technical or trade school and post-graduate work, including a master's degree, doctorate, or professional program. Funds for a second bachelor's degree or trade/technical program certification are also available. Since its inception in 2007, Folds of Honor has awarded about 44,000 scholarships totaling about \$200 million in all 50 states. Among the students served, 41

percent are minorities. It is rated a four-star charity by Charity Navigator and Platinum on GuideStar. It was founded by Lt Col Dan Rooney, the only-ever F-16 fighter pilot (with three combat tours in Iraq) and PGA Professional. He is currently stationed at Headquarters Air Force Recruiting Service Detachment 1, at Joint Base San Antonio-Randolph, Texas.
